# Help HER Run!!! By Char Kahler, Public Policy

We only have until October 25, 2011 to encourage women to run!! That is when filings close for the office of Martin County 1<sup>st</sup> District Commissioner. Then we will have until the election on February 14, 2012 to support a qualified woman in her campaign.

The 1<sup>st</sup> District includes the eastern townships or Westford, Nashville, Center Creek, Pleasant Prairie, Fairmont and East Chain. The towns are Truman, Granada, East Chain and a portion of NE Fairmont. Within Fairmont it is Ward 4, Precinct 2 (areas east of N. North Avenue & N. Prairie as far south as Blue Earth Avenue. Even though Commissioner terms are for 4 years, she would be filling out the remaining term of Gerald Boler. Should she win, she would have to run again for the Nov. 6, 2012 election. At that time the District 4 seat held by Dan Schmidtke will also be on the ballot.

Women comprise 50.8% of our county's population, yet we do not have a woman representing us. Minnesota women hold 37 percent of the state's public school board seats, 12 percent of county commissioner seats, and 26 percent of city council seats. Fortunately we have some brave women on city councils: Ceylon-Kathy Bremer; Dunnell-Bessie Reinhardt; Granada-Melissa Engel; Trimont-Karen Koeder, Truman-Kathy Hendricksen and Welcome-Kim Holm. Only one woman mayor—Darliss Green in Granada.

Information on Fairmont's City Council was requested at our AAUW Board meeting. Up for election in 2012 are: Ward 2 held by Harlan Gorath,

Ward 4 held by Andy Lucas

At-Large held by Wes Clerc.

These are four year terms with filings open from August 2 to 16, 2012.

Ward 1 held by Darin Rahm, Ward 3 held by Joe Kallemeyn and Mayor held by Randy Quiring will have elections in 2014.

Many other elections will take place in 2012: US President & Vice President, US Senate & Representatives and MN State Senate & Representatives.

We have help for women pursuing public office from the Women Candidate Development Coalition (WCDC). It is a coalition of nine major Minnesota women's/feminist organizations committed to legal and economic rights for women and girls. WCDC's mission is to provide the education and assistance needed to motivate and empower progressive women, regardless of political party, to become actively involved in all aspects of Minnesota's politics and government, from voting to running for office.
